With the membership level designated "Fellow of the Society", the American Vacuum Society (AVS) annually awards scientists in the community who have made sustained and outstanding technical contributions in areas of interest to AVS. Within AVS, Beatriz Roldán Cuenya is serving as associate editor of the Journal of Vacuum Science and Technology B and has taught an AVS-sponsored short course on Nanophysics.

Prof. Roldán Cuenya receives the AVS Fellow Award for her "exceptional contributions to the mechanistic understanding of thermal and electrocatalytic reactions based on well-defined nanostructured materials combined with advanced in situ and operando microscopic and spectroscopic characterization".
