On Monday, 26th of February, the Berlin University Alliance (<u>BUA</u>) invited the seven Berlin Clusters of Excellence and the three new Cluster initiatives to a networking event at Humboldt Lab with Berlin politicians, notably the Senator for Higher Education and Research, Health and Long-Term Care Ina Czyborra and the Major Kai Wegner.
